



DRESS CODE

1. Dress Code:

The Lake Arrowhead Country Club is an exclusive, member-owned, private country club located in a rural resort area and, as such, adheres to a relaxed, but conservative, dress code. Tasteful and appropriate attire is expected at all times. Members are asked to not only willingly comply with the code, but to make their family and guests aware of the requirements and ensure that they comply. Our staff has been authorized by the Board of Directors to enforce the dress code and to refuse service to anyone not in compliance. Members or guests who do not meet these requirements will not be allowed to use the club's facilities.

1. Attire: The required mode of dress is "Country Club Casual" unless otherwise specified.
 - For men that consists of collared (including turtleneck and mock turtle) and sleeved shirts with or without a sweater or jacket, and tailored slacks or golf shorts, with the exception of proper tennis attire. All shirts must be tucked in at all times (unless otherwise designed) when dining in our Summit Dining area, on the Golf Course and golf practice facilities.
 - Women may wear dresses, blouses or sweaters (including collarless and/or sleeveless) and skirts, slacks, capris, golf shorts or skorts.
 - Those playing Golf or using the Golf Practice Facilities must comply with the dress code as they are specified in the Golf Rules, paragraph 8, titled "Attire".
 - Tennis/Pickleball players may wear tennis shorts and collared or collarless tennis shirts. All members and guests must comply with the dress code as they are specified in the Tennis/Pickleball Rules, paragraph 7, titled "Attire".
 - Denim material and jeans are not allowed on the golf course, including the practice areas, but may be worn in all other areas of the club.
 - All clothing should be neat, clean and pressed.
 - Caps and visors must be worn bill forward.
 - Proper footwear is required, except around the pool. Golf shoes must have soft spikes or be spike less. No metal spikes are allowed. Tennis Shoes must be non-marking.
 - Scheduled events may have a modified dress code that is at the discretion of the General Manager.
2. Inappropriate Dress: Rules cannot be written that can possibly address every instance of inappropriate dress, but here are some requirements.
 - No ripped, soiled, stained, frayed, cut off, or see-through clothing.
 - No T-shirts (with the exception of proper tennis/pickleball attire), cropped tops, tube tops, tank tops, halter or bra type tops, except in the pool area. Suitable warm-up suits are allowed. No sweat suits.
 - No external cargo pants/shorts, camo or fatigue wear. Shorts and pants with flat pockets for decorative design are permitted.
 - Undergarments should never be visible.
 - No shorts, skirts or skorts more than 6" above the knee excluding proper tennis/pickleball attire.
 - Slacks and shorts must be worn at the waistline.
 - No sweats, work-out, spandex or gym attire (suitable warm up suits are allowed).
 - No swimsuits, except in the pool area.
 - Those using the pool must:
 - Enter and leave the clubhouse through the Pub Level, after checking in at the Front Desk.
 - Wear cover-ups and proper footwear when outside the pool area.
